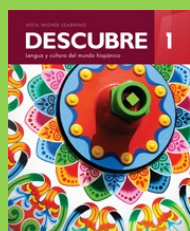

- ♦ **Follow all school rules.** Appropriate school behavior is expected at ALL times.

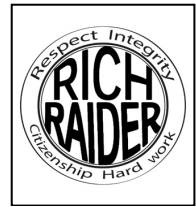
### World Language Honor Code
